

ADDENDUM: Special Flight Rules for Discover Flying RC Field

- LIMITS TO OUR AIRSPACE - Flying over the full-scale airport at the west end of our runway is prohibited and will be strictly enforced. The end of the grassy area and beginning of the shrubbery is the limit of our airspace. A stationary RC plane has been posted at the far west end of the field as a reminder.
- MEDICAL BOX - First pilot to arrive at the field is responsible for opening the Medical Box. Last pilot leaving for the day must lock the box and scramble the code to 0000. Also ensure that the port-a potty and main gate locks are locked and set to zeros if you are last to leave.
- PIT SAFETY - Taxiing aircraft toward the pit area is prohibited. Do not taxi past the two small signs directly behind the flight line. Lock your throttle and carry your aircraft back toward the pit area. In the interest of aircraft safety, please hanger your planes behind the setup stands when not in use.
- FLIGHT LINE PROTECTION - All pilots and observers should stand behind the flight line fence while planes are in flight.
- FIRST PERSON VIEW - FPV pilots are required to have a designated spotter at all times.
- "ON THE FIELD" WARNING - Clearly announce your intentions before entering the runway. Other pilots should acknowledge the "on the field" warning. It is also best practice to announce your intention to land or touch and go, including the direction of your landing approach.
- EXPERIMENTAL AIRCRAFT - Pilots flying experimental or scratch-built aircraft must wait for clear airspace before initial flights. Once your plane is proven airworthy, normal flying rules can apply.

Please note these regulations are in place for your safety as well as the safety of all club members, their guests, and full-scale pilots at the Marstons Mills Airport. They are in addition to the posted flight rules found on the website.

Violations will result in verbal then written warnings; and could result in further disciplinary action by club officers.
